Set alongside the mighty Columbia River

Bordered by Revelstoke National Park, gliding through giant hemlocks and cedar, and sitting tight alongside the Columbia River, the setting at the Revelstoke Golf Club couldn't be better. The club, which opened in 1924, is one of the oldest and most scenic courses in British Columbia.

Interestingly, the course sits on the former site of an old equestrian racetrack. "The only thing racing now are the golfers trying to get in as many holes as they can before dark", says John Franks, Revelstoke's new Head Pro/General Manager. "Our members are proud of their club, but they are always very receptive

to visitors." The par-four 6th, which clings to the banks of the Columbia, is a perennial favourite.

The club also features a classic 1911 clubhouse that used to serve as headquarters for the horse races. Of course, the centerpiece of the property is the pastoral 6,521-yard championship course. Win, place or show, you'll be happy you spent a day at this classic venue!

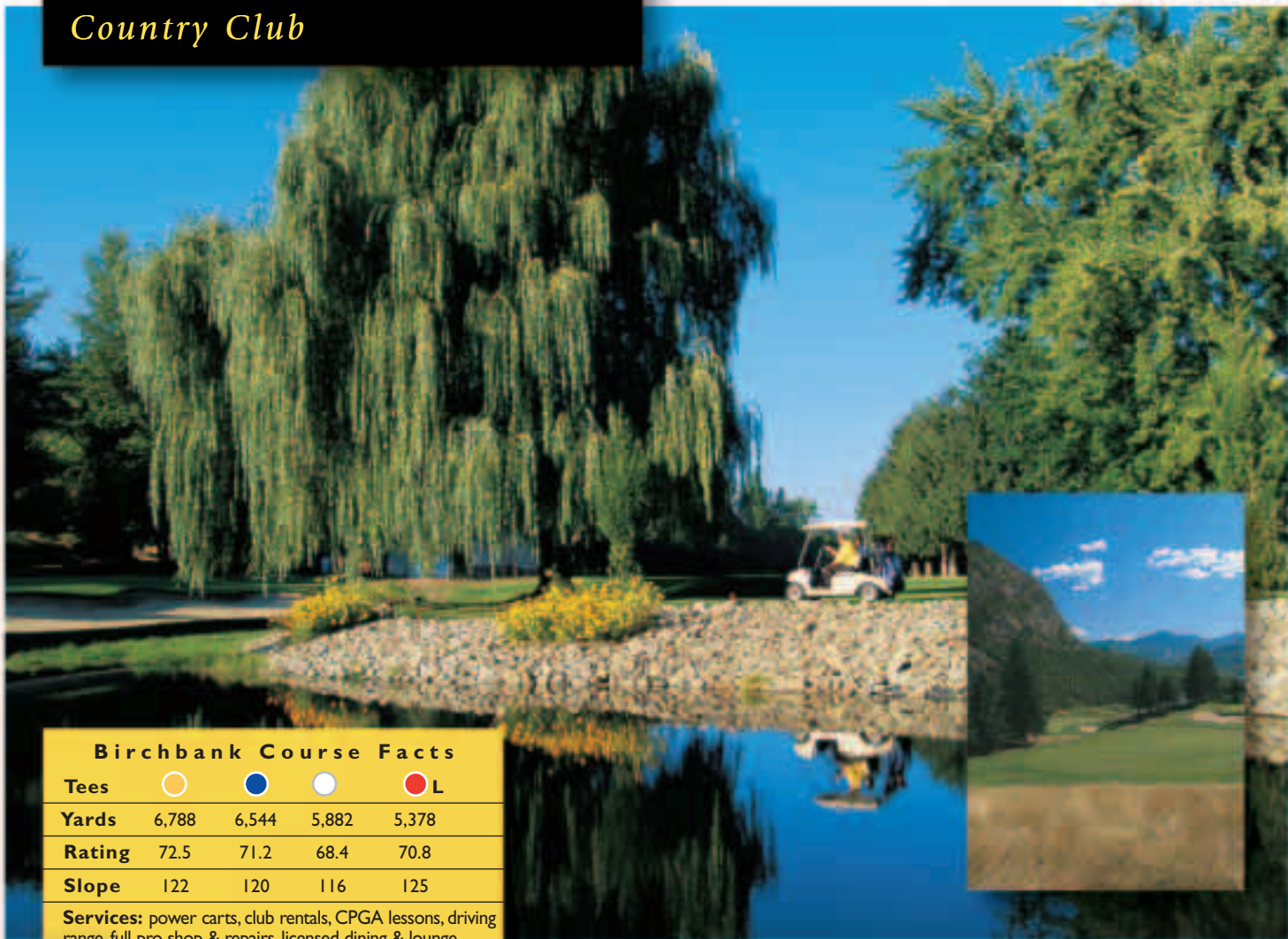

Birchbank Course

The word 'unique' is not uncommon when writers describe top-ranked golf facilities. In the case of the beautiful 27-hole Rossland-Trail Country Club, 'unique' is hardly adequate. Preserved in the heart of Rossland, and dating back to 1928, the charming 9-hole Rossland Course is historic heaven for golf purists. Hilly (there is a tow-rope to assist golfers on one hole) and loaded with character, the Rossland course is about as fun as golf gets.

The longer 18-hole Birchbank Course is a tree-lined jewel that features glorious views of the Columbia River. As a host for the

BC Amateur Championship, Birchbank is a tremendous shot-maker's test with large, undulating greens. "The view from the 4th tee is unbelievable," says Head Pro Kevin Nesbitt. "Most people find it difficult to concentrate on that corner of the golf course."

A complete golf experience with extraordinary character, the Rossland-Trail Country Club is a place you'll want to visit. Play 27-holes, then unwind in Rossland's charming log clubhouse!





Another sunny day in Castlegar

Four-star courses from Golf Digest don't come easy. The Castlegar Golf Club has just that distinction. Overlooking the city of Castlegar, high above the Columbia River with mouth-watering vistas, the Castlegar Golf Club offers golfers the best of both worlds: fabulous golf with eye-popping scenery. "The rating from Golf Digest was a feather in our cap," says GM Brian Miller. "Since 1955 the folks living here have realized this place is very special."

Castlegar's 6,677-yard course traverses through mature trees and uses the natural features of the land incredibly well. The par-four ninth

A beautiful clubhouse with sensational views

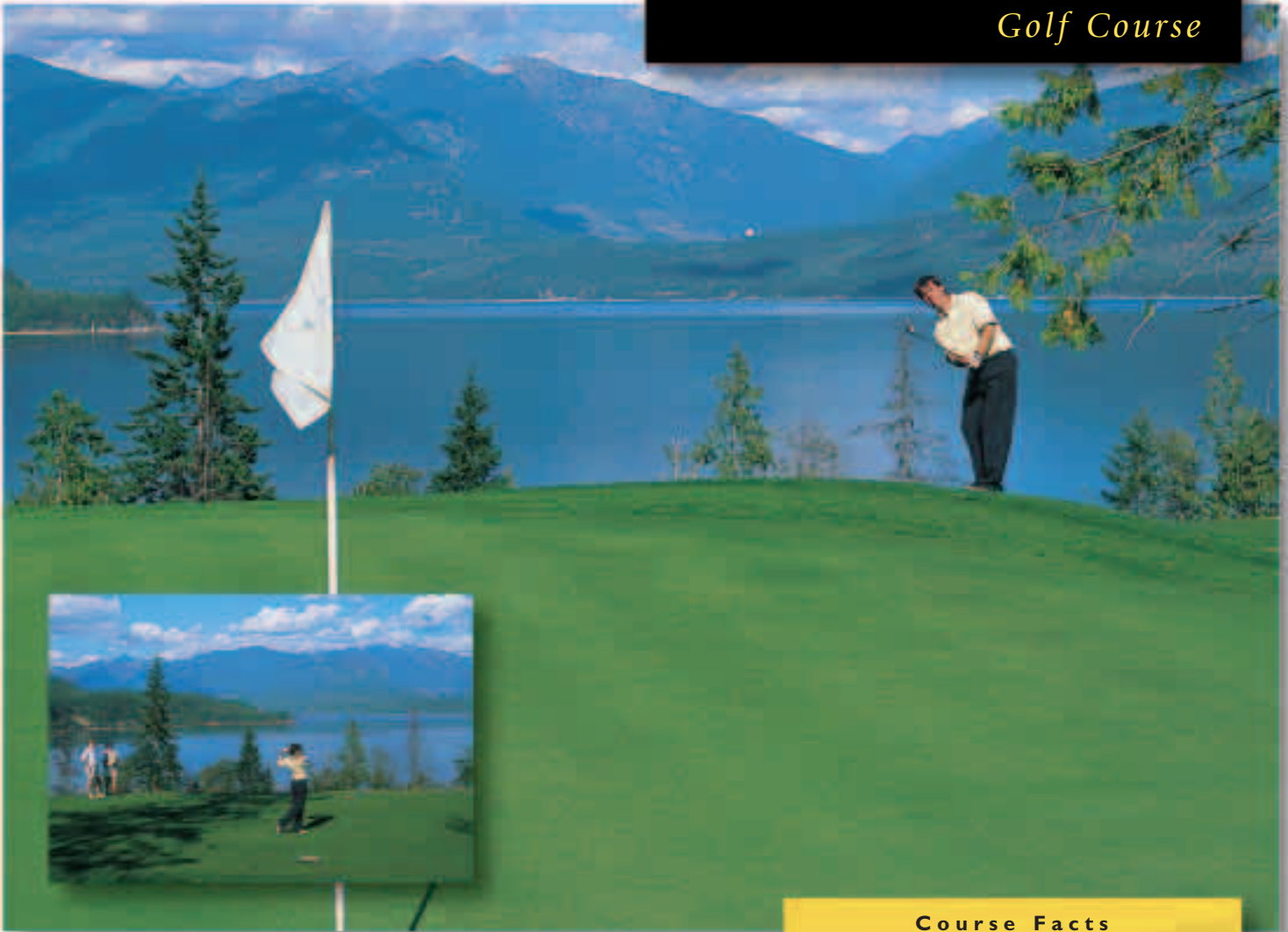
Overlooking one of Canada's most celebrated mountain cities, with splendid views of Kokanee Glacier Provincial Park, the Granite Pointe Golf Club is yet another gem in the BC Rockies. The course, which underwent a complete overhaul by acclaimed architect Bill Newis in 1993, traverses through hilly terrain and features a number of risk-reward holes requiring precise shot-making.

Unfortunately, 'precise shot-making' can be hampered by the many magnificent vistas golfers are treated to while playing the course. The par-four 16th – which was chosen as one of the top 10 holes in BC - is a great example. Here golfers

paint their tee shots against a backdrop that includes the crystal waters of Kootenay Lake, the historic buildings of Nelson and the famed Kokanee Glacier!

Not surprisingly, many people who come to Nelson never leave. A visit to the Granite Pointe Golf Course, capped off with a great meal in their beautiful new clubhouse, may have you longing to become a resident also!

As the crystal waters of Kootenay Lake roll onto the sandy shores below the Balfour Golf Course - and the nearby peaks glisten against the steel-blue sky – a common thought is: “does it get any better than this?” The short answer: no.

The Balfour Golf Course is a fantastic Les Furber creation that's cut through huge fir trees near the shores of Kootenay Lake. Opening in the spring of 2003 will be a gorgeous new clubhouse. The course has also added two new tees – and 300 yards in length – to a course that is already considered one of BC's unsung heroes. The superb par-five 17th, which aims golfers straight to the

shimmering lake, is part of a climactic three-hole stretch to close the round. “The finish is always something golfers look forward to,” says GM Reg Clarkson. “But the entire course is one big photo-op.”

Visitors to Balfour can enjoy a host of recreational opportunities and attractions found nearby including the soothing waters of Ainsworth Hot Springs and historic Nelson. Discover the Balfour Golf Course this summer!
