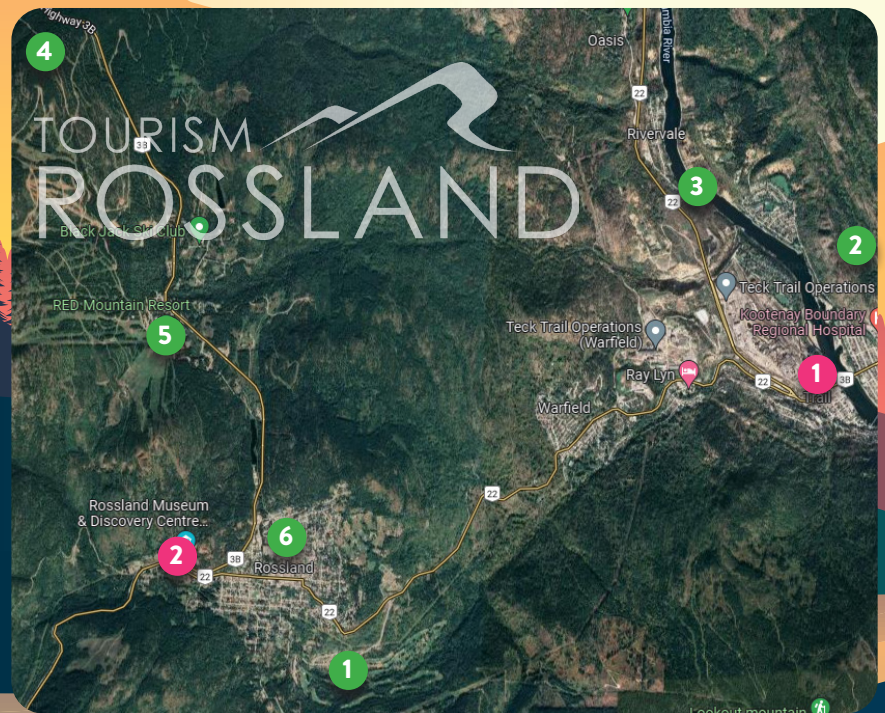

Regional tourism is a driving force for a thriving visitor economy in the West Kootenays. So go ahead - be nosey - and go explore what your neighbours have to offer.

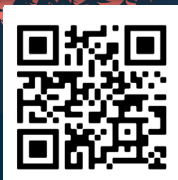

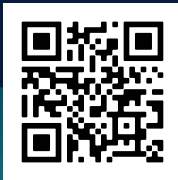
